The competition will take place on:

Topic: "Laws like the Crown Act passed in several states overstep the employer hair and appearance policies that impact all employees. As long as employers are not intentionally targeting one protected group over another, they should be free to regulate hair in the workplace." Refute or defend this statement.

Format:

- 300-500 Word <u>Oration</u>
- Each page should contain student's name and page number
- Submitted as a Word Document
- 12 point font
- Double spaced

• Notice on Plagiarism: essay should be written and presented in the students' own words; facts should be cited from reputable sources.

Noted Judges will judge each oration based on the following criteria:

- Content, Originality, Logic, Organization, Grammar, Delivery, and Cited Research
- Opinions that are based on facts and cited resources.

<u>Rehearsals</u>: Each competitor is required to attend 1 virtual practice session and 1 in person practice session which will be scheduled prior to the competition.

<u>Awards</u>:

There will be three winners; each will receive a trophy and a monetary award.

- All competitors will receive a Certificate of Participation.
- Since this is an oratorical competition, <u>competitors must deliver their persuasive</u> <u>essays</u> to be eligible for the awards; orations may be recorded prior to the competition depending on the number of contestants and available technology
- Seniors who compete in this contest are eligible for our annual Scholarship Award in May. More information will follow.
