# Topic:

The late Congressman John Lewis said, "The vote is precious. It is almost sacred. It's the most powerful non-violent tool we have in a democratic society, and we've got to use it."

In 2020 63% of eligible African American voters voted in the presidential election while in 2008 65% of eligible African American voters voted in the presidential election that elected President Barack Obama.

Voting is the most powerful tool available to African Americans to impact change in our communities. Refute or defend this statement.

#### **Format:**

- 300-500 Word **Oration**
- Each page should contain student's name and page number
- Submitted as a Word Document
- 12 point font
- Double spaced
- Notice on Plagiarism: essay should be written and presented in the students' own words; facts should be cited from reputable sources

## Noted Judges will judge each oration based on the following criteria:

- Content, Originality, Logic, Organization, Grammar, Delivery, and Cited Research
- Opinions that are based on facts and cited resources.

**Rehearsals:** Each competitor is required to attend 1 virtual practice session which will be scheduled prior to the competition.

#### Awards:

There will be **three winners**; each will receive a trophy and a monetary award.

- All competitors will receive a Certificate of Participation.
- Since this is an oratorical competition, <u>competitors must deliver their persuasive</u> <u>essays in real time</u> to be eligible for the awards. However, orations may be recorded prior to the competition as a failsafe to be played in the event there are technology issues on the day of the competition preventing delivery in real time.
- Seniors who compete in this contest are automatically eligible for our annual \$1,500.00 Scholarship Award in May. More information will follow.
